RESOLUTION 2009-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE HAMPTON ROADS METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION TO ENDORSE A COMPREHENSIVE TRAINING PROGRAM FOR MEMBERS OF THE HRMPO BOARD AND ITS ADVISORY COMMITTEES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Hampton Roads Metropolitan Planning Organization (HRMPO), designated by the Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia as the policy body responsible for the urban transportation planning and programming process of the Hampton Roads Metropolitan Planning Area, which includes the cities of Chesapeake, Hampton, Newport News, Norfolk, Poquoson, Portsmouth, Suffolk, Virginia Beach, and Williamsburg; the counties of Isle of Wight, James City, and York; and a portion of Gloucester County; in accordance with Section 134, Title 23, United States Code (23 USC 134) and applicable federal and state regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the HRMPO Board has determined that it is in the best interest of members of the Board and its Advisory Committees to enhance their understanding of the transportation planning and programming process, their roles within the process, and the relationship to community and societal goals; and

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Planning Capacity Building (TPCB) Program, a collaborative effort of the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA) designed to help decision makers resolve the increasingly complex issues they face when addressing transportation needs in their communities, has been recognized to be a comprehensive resource for applicable training;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Hampton Roads Metropolitan Planning Organization hereby directs the Executive Director and HRMPO staff to coordinate with FHWA and FTA to provide training to the members of the Board and its Advisory Committees and to provide updates to such training as deemed necessary.
